Grades 6-8

Merit Scholarship • Award amount: \$400

one-time award

Criteria: Student takes the Middle School Placement Test and scores two or more grade levels higher than her current grade and/or her standardized test scores reflect testing achievement two or more grade levels higher than her current grade in a minimum of one category including Math, English or Science. Merit Scholarship recipients are notified by mail. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Providence Alumnae Scholarship • Award amount \$100

one-time scholarship

Criteria: Students may submit one character reference from one Providence alumna recommending them to Providence and will be awarded a \$100 scholarship. Letters should include the applicant's full name and grade she is applying for as well as the name, year of graduation and contact information of the alumna. An admissions application to Providence must be on file for the student to be eligible for this scholarship. Alumnae may only submit one letter of reference for one student per school year. Scholarship applies to students who complete the admissions process and register at Providence as a new student in grades 6-8 for the 2012/2013 school year. *This scholarship does not apply to students who are currently enrolled at Providence in grades 6-8. Scholarship is applied to tuition during the second semester. Must be on file when student registers at Providence. Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Grade 9

Bridge Scholarship • Award amount: \$1000

one-time award

Awarded to all students attending Providence for the eighth grade (2011/2012) who register to attend Providence as a freshman (2012/2013). The Bridge Scholarship is given each year to help bridge the tuition gap between the middle and high school divisions.

Moye Academic Excellence Scholarship • Award amount: \$1000

one-time award

Awarded to the eighth grade student with the highest GPA who has attended Providence Catholic School for both 7th and 8th grades and is registered to attend Providence Catholic School as a freshman. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Hingst Family Scholarship Award • Award amount: \$1000

one-time award

Criteria: Submit a typed essay (approximately 300 words) entitled "What A Providence Education Means To Me" and a letter of recommendation from the sponsor of a community service project or organization you have been involved in this past year. Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$4,000
awarded annually in the amount of \$1,000

Criteria: 8th grade student takes the High School Placement Test (HSPT) administered at Providence and scores at or above the 95th percentile. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Academic Scholarship • Award amount \$3,200
awarded annually in the amount of \$800

Criteria: 8th grade student takes the High School Placement Test (HSPT) administered at Providence and scores at or above the 90th percentile. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$750
one-time scholarship

Criteria: based on admissions committee review of transcripts and standardized test scores reflecting academic achievement two or more grade levels higher than her current grade in a minimum of three categories including Math, English or Science. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$600
one-time scholarship

Criteria: based on admissions committee review of transcripts and standardized test scores reflecting academic achievement two or more grade levels higher than her current grade in a minimum of two categories including Math, English or Science.

Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$500
one-time scholarship

Criteria: based on admissions committee review of transcripts and standardized test scores reflecting achievement two or more grade levels higher than her current grade in a minimum of one category including Math, English or Science. *Please bring a copy of your scholarship letter to the Business Office when registering.*

Grades 9-11

Providence Alumnae Scholarship • Award amount \$200
one-time scholarship

Criteria: Students may submit one character reference from one Providence alumna recommending them to Providence for high school. Letters should include the applicant's full name and grade she is applying for as well as the name, year of graduation and contact information of the alumna. An admissions application to Providence must be on file for the student to be eligible for this scholarship. Alumnae may only submit one letter of reference for one student per school year. Scholarship applies to students who complete the admissions process and register at Providence as a freshman or as a transfer in grades 10 and 11 for the 2011/2012 school year. *This scholarship does not apply to students who are currently enrolled at Providence in the 8th grade. Scholarship is applied to tuition during the second semester. Must be on file when student registers at Providence.*

Other Available Discounts

Send A Friend • Amount: \$500

Registered Providence family recommends a new family to Providence as indicated on admissions application. Referral information must be stated on admissions application and tuition agreement at the time of registration. *Both families must be registered and attending Providence through the first semester of the school year and the discount is applied to tuition for both families during the second semester.*

Sibling Discount • Amount: \$250

Registered students at Providence who are siblings receive a \$250 sibling discount per student (\$500 per family). Families with a sibling registered at Central Catholic receive one \$250 sibling discount applied to their daughter's tuition.
