The information in the questionnaire is used to match you with a Providence Ambassador who shares your interests whenever possible.

Keep in mind, shadowing is just a small sample of a day in the life of one Providence student. It is not a reflection of the actual schedule you may one day follow. Your individual interests and activities will vary and enhance your overall high school experience.

- **Schedule:** Shadow students and their parent or guardian are asked to be in the school lobby between 7:30am and 7:45am to fill out and sign a brief permission slip.

Parent or guardian can plan to meet their student in the school lobby at 3:00pm when the school day ends.
