The college preparatory curriculum for a Providence middle school student is both meaningful and challenging. Girls in sixth, seventh and eighth grade are prepared for the rigorous courses offered in the high school and also are given opportunities to explore the fine arts, foreign languages, and computer technology courses.

Enriched curriculum - Latin, French or Spanish, Technology, Arts, Drama, Choir and Dance.

Eighth grade students can earn high school credits in Foreign Language, Algebra, Technology Fine Arts & Journalism.

*Stanford 10 Achievement Test scores are at or above the national level and above the archdiocesan scores.*

*25% of 7th graders qualify for the Duke Talent Identification Program each year based on their Stanford Achievement Tests.*
