Open House is an open invitation to all parents and students to visit our campus and **get to know us!** At these events you will have a chance to tour the campus with a student or parent ambassador. Teachers and academic counselors will be available to answer questions about curriculum. The athletic department will have a coach on hand to inform you about the athletic opportunities available at Providence, and representatives from the performing arts department will share their exciting schedule.

Practice High School Placement Test is an opportunity for your daughter to take a practice run at the High School Placement Test. This will give her a chance to experience for herself the questions like those that will be on the test as well as build her confidence.

High School Placement Test (HSPT) is an entrance exam to Providence. This standardized test is used by all the San Antonio Catholic High Schools, and the test has three sections: English, Math and Essay. Pencils, water and a snack will be provided.

Middle School Placement Test (MSPT) is an entrance exam to Providence. (*The only All Girls Middle School in San Antonio!*) This standardized assessment test has three sections: English, Math and Essay. Pencils, water and a snack will be provided.

Parent Tour and Parent Q&A are opportunities to tour the Providence campus, meet faculty and staff, and **get to know us** while your daughter takes the test.

New Student Registration is a set time that you can bring your paperwork and get your daughter registered and ready to start the next school year. Staff will be available to assist you with the registration process, set up a payment plan, guide you with uniform information and more.
